| Term | Term in which you want to search for a course: Fall, Spring, Summer, Winter |
| Session | Subset of the term, there are many sessions throughout the term with different start dates. |
| Subject | The subject category of the course you wish to take
ENGL=English. This is a required field when using the basic search |
| Course Number | A Subset of the chosen subject: ENGL <u>101</u> |
| Course Keyword | Searches for the entered word in the description or title of a course |
| Campus | The UArizona has many campuses that offer courses, your assigned campus will be the default value |
| Location | Each campus may have several locations, your location will default |
| Show open classes | Shows only courses that are available to enroll in. Un-select to view closed courses |

Course Attribute

A characteristic a group of courses have in common such as General Education or Honors

Class Number

A 5 digit number associated with a certain course in a specified term: 56743

Course Component

Courses can have multiple components: Lab and Lecture

Instructor Last Name

The primary course instructors last name

Mode of Instruction

Courses can have different modes in which they are taught:
In person, Fully Online, Hybrid

Interdisciplinary Interest Area

Course Career

The career for which that course is taught: Undergraduate, Graduate, Law

Units

The number of units a course may be taken for

Meeting time

The time of day the course is schedule to meet

Days of the week

The days of the week the course is scheduled to meet
